- 1.1. **Description.** The ADC Office is an independent tenant office servicing the base. The ADC Office must be located in a building separate from the Base Legal Facility and the Special Victim Counsel. The perception of the ADC as a separate entity from the Staff Judge Advocate (SJA) office is essential to its ability to function as an independent counsel. The ADC Office requires space for Defense Counsel, Paralegal, Visiting Attorney, Administrative Support, and Waiting area.
- 1.2. **Requirements Determination.** In order to prevent perception of command influence, do not combine law centers and ADC offices unless designated by AF/JA. At locations designated by AF/JA, collocate a circuit defense counsel office with the ADC Office and include additional office and administrative space. The size for the ADC Office is determined by their total staffing in accordance with Table 1.1.
- 1.3. Scope Determination. See Table 1.1 below.
- 1.4. **Design Considerations.** Special Purpose Space required includes a waiting room/reception area, professional staff offices, administrative office, visiting attorney office, team huddle room, and a break area.
