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Subject: Revision to the 2014 Engineering and Construction Awards Nomination Requirements

Applicability: Guidance

1. ECBs Purpose. The purpose of this Engineering and Construction Bulletin (ECB) is to provide the references, suspense date, and links to eligibility criteria, and submission requirements for all the 2014 awards programs sponsored by the Engineering and Construction Community of Practice. The dates of submission have changed to have alignment with awards panel review and selection.

2. All E&C HQUSACE awards will have the same suspense date of **1 April 2014** for submission of nominations for HQUSACE review unless prevented by specific award requirements.
